Introduction

I want you to work with you and this is my portfolio.

When an artist interviews for a job, they bring a portfolio with examples of their work so the employer can decide if they are a good fit for the company or project. Authentic Tarot readers have much in common with artists. From cave paintings to Da Vinci to Warhol, art has many different styles and genres. No two artists are exactly alike. No two psychics work exactly alike. There is no ultimate psychic authority. There is no official right or wrong way to do a Tarot reading. Tarot is artistry and spirituality, not rules and regulations. One thing is certain: If you read this booklet, a Tarot reading with me will meet or exceed your expectations because you will know exactly what to expect in advance.

There aren't many Tarot portfolios around. So how do you know who you can trust to do your psychic reading? The best advice, of course, is follow your own instincts. Pay attention to your deep down, reflex *feelings* when you look at a website or advertisement. Because of religious and cultural prejudices that are on the rise in many parts of the United States, some of the best psychics and Tarot readers are very quiet about what they do. It may take some searching on your part to find anyone at all. Once you find someone who does readings, talk to them for a minute and ask reasonable questions. Don't pour out your heart to a stranger or try to get an impromptu free reading over the phone. Instead, ask practical questions like location, prices, payment, scheduling and so on. Their demeanor in a non-Tarot conversation will give you a sense of the level of professionalism they will bring to the Tarot reading itself. If they seem evasive, impatient or leave you feeling uncertain, then honor those feelings and look for someone else. If it feels right and you can afford it, try a session. If it is a good match, you'll know right away. A good Tarot session inspires, empowers and reassures you. A reading should never frighten you, make you feel judged, or feel as if you have done something wrong. If it isn't a good experience, simply try again with someone else. A personality clash doesn't mean that the reader is deceptive. By the same token, you should never take it personally or feel that a bad session was your fault for "not believing" or any such nonsense. Of course, always use plenty of common sense to steer clear of scams. "Psychics" that make outrageous promises or make repeating or increasing demands on your time (and money) are best avoided.

Thanks to the Internet, no matter where you live, you can get affordable, expert, compassionate Tarot readings. Distance Tarot is my specialty. In this booklet, we'll look at the basic structure underneath *all* of my readings, both distance and in-person. No matter whether we work face-to-face or remotely, no matter whether we are working with Tarot, Reiki or Meditation, I follow the same ethics and standards that I applied in my mainstream medical work. All policies are transparent, written in plain English, and found in the "Fine Print" chapter at the end of this booklet.

Following your instincts, combined with a little common sense can help you find an excellent psychic. I hope that once you read this, your instincts will be to get a reading with me.

## The Bones Of It

The details of a person's face is unique to them, but underneath we all share basically the same skeleton. Tarot is a bit like that. The details of your reading are totally unique and for you alone. All of the individual readings I do have the same core pattern and structure, regardless of whether they are in-person or distance, live or recorded, spoken or written.

My readings include:

**Introduction:** We will talk about the questions or concerns that brought you to the reading. For distance readings this happens during the ordering process. The secure ordering systems I use (PayPal, Etsy) give you a chance to use "instructions to the merchant" or "customize" buttons to let me know your question or to request an open reading. Questions do not have to be detailed or specific. You can just give a general topic, like career, romance or what-have-you. It is perfectly fine to leave a reading completely open and not ask a question at all. Some of the best readings happen when we let spirit lead the way. Talk or type, the short introduction of your name and question/topic/request for open is the thing that connects my intuition to your message and gets the process started.

**Card Shuffle and Layout:** In distance readings I simply shuffle until it intuitively feels right. In a live reading I'll ask you how many times you want the deck to be shuffled. The cards are placed on the table face up in the layout pattern that you ordered. The layouts will be explained in more detail shortly.

**General Pattern:** We look at the cards as a whole picture. This can include things like major vs minor arcana, distribution of the minor suits, repeating numbers, where cards cluster within the layout, or any purely intuitive impressions that may appear.

**Card by card:** We talk about each card individually including its meaning, the meaning of its position within the layout and the type of message it is giving (advice, caution, validation, etc.)

**Summary "psychic reading":** This puts all the cards back together in one summary. In this part, we will also listen for any purely intuitive information that might come through whether it is directly related to your cards or not. This is a chance to hear things that are needed, even if they are not requested or expected. There are NO guarantees about the information that will come through here. No one gets everything, but this part might include; colors, crystals, aromatherapy, positive affirmations, spirit guide messages, and on *very rare* occasions, crossed over loved ones.

**Sigil Element / Intuitive Doodles:** For in-person sessions, I will make handwritten notes for you to take with you. If any mental images come up, I'll *sometimes* be able to draw shapes to help show you what I'm seeing in my mind's eye. Great art they are not. If anything these little psychic doodles look like petroglyphs, hieroglyphs or some kind of circuit schematics. For lack of a better name, I call them "sigil elements" and they are always included in the InkMagick pen and paper readings through the TaoCraft Tarot shop.

**Q&A:** You are always welcome to ask questions throughout the reading process. If we are working live, in-person or over the phone, please feel free to ask your questions as they come up. Questions in real time can lead a reading to some of the most interesting places! If we are working at distance, questions are welcome too, but are clustered to the beginning and end of the reading. All distance readings include a follow up email at no extra charge. I check email multiple times each business day.

Turn of a Friendly Card: The Layout Patterns

No matter which of these layouts you choose, the reading progresses in the same fundamental way we talked about in the last chapter. All of the layouts are available by email, although some are only seasonally available (like Zombie Cat at Halloween.) Individual in-person sessions and InkMagick pen and ink readings are only available as 7 card layouts. Phone and video readings have both the seven and five card layouts to choose from.

The most important thing to remember about any of the layouts is simply this: NONE of them predict the future. I specifically wrote or modified ALL of them to give the greatest possible respect to your choices and your actions. The one card meditation is ubiquitous, as old as Tarot readings. The Pathway layout is the old past-present-future layout reimagined with a more modern, choice-oriented spin. The five card “Modern Oracle” and the seven card “expanded Modern Oracle” layouts are my creations. Both build on the pathway reading. Four seasons is also my layout that gives you ideas, themes or navigation points for the year ahead. Zombie cat is an embellished version of a yes/no layout of unknown origin.

One Card Meditation: This is just as it says, a single card. This is helpful for both ends of the Tarot experience and focus spectrum.

On one hand, the one card meditation is an excellent way for absolute beginners to learn the Tarot deck. It has the broadest focus of any reading. It usually gives a large, vague idea for you to ponder and see how it unfolds for you. I use these meditation style readings in the blog. Blog and YouTube one card meditations are softly focused because they are intended to read broad energies for an even broader audience.

On the other hand, an experienced reader can pull one card with laser focus to get a narrow insight on a very specific question, or to get a quick update on a question that has been explored before in a larger reading. I typically reserve these tightly focused one card readings for long-time clients who have had multiple longer

readings with me for an ongoing issue. For the most part, I follow my intuition which level of focus is needed in any given one card reading.

Three Card Pathway: This layout shows the path you are now and the direction it is headed, but does not predict the future. It helps you to steer your path toward the future you wish to create. This layout includes

- Lessons From the Past: things you have done well or lessons you have learned that you can bring forward to help you now.
- Current Situation: Energies around you that can help you understand current circumstances
- Moving Forward: Ideas to help you move forward in the direction you want to go.

Five Card Modern Oracle: I wrote this layout around 2003, inspired by the Oracle character in the first Matrix movie. It starts with the pathway cards then adds

- Advice and Choices: This is a card to show the place where you can make the biggest difference in your path. It is a pivot point. You can use the energies here to change the direction of your current path if you choose to change, or you can use it to help stay on course if you like the way things are going.
- Alternative path: This card hints at other paths that are easily open to you if you want to make a change. If this card is close to the 'moving forward' card, then it is a hint that you are already on the best path.

Seven Card Expanded Modern Oracle: This is the largest layout that I offer. In my experience, any readings larger than this can deteriorate into circular logic and contradictions very easily. This layout provides detail, but stays focused. It builds on the Modern Oracle five card spread using the pathway cards, the advice and alternative cards, but adds

- Helpful Energies: Things that are working in your favor and can act like a wind at your back when you are on the right path.
- Potential Challenges: This doesn't predict problems. It is simply a heads-up to *potential* challenges. Keep an eye out for them, and you can act to prevent problems or take care of them early on before they grow big.

Four Seasons: This layout is especially popular at New Years, graduations, anniversaries and birthdays. It gives one card for each season of the coming year,

beginning with the session in which the reading is done. Each season card gives a theme for each a three month period. Then it gives a single card that is the overarching theme for the year as a whole.

Zombie Cat's Yes or No Tarot: This is a simple yes or no answer to any one yes or no question. Zombie Cat is a character I created in the Tarotbytes blog on ModernOracleTarot.com in 2015. These readings are lighthearted, just for fun, and come with a liberal sprinkling of snark and humor. Zombie Cat readings are 100% guaranteed to contain words, but have a 50% chance of being dead wrong.

## Example Reading

What follows is an actual email Tarot reading. It was graciously donated by the client to give you an inside look at how these readings really look. Any personally identifying information has been changed or removed to protect their privacy. To get a feel for a live phone or in-person sessions, think of this as a written transcript of what was said. The things I say in live Tarot sessions are identical to the things I type in email sessions, because they both come from the same inner intuitive source.

My role in a reading is like a translator. Intuition speaks in mental images, words, sounds, feelings, even fragrance. My job as a psychic intuitive is to translate

abstract spirit and energy into actual words and language that you can use. I'm the messenger. What follows is one person's message. Your message will be different, unique, and just for you.

Your Cards Today Are:

- Lessons from the Past: King of Pentacles (Coins)
- Current Situation: Three of Swords
- Moving Forward: King of Swords

### General Pattern

All cards are minor arcana, which in a layout this small is no real statistical surprise. Intuitively it feels like a bit of reassurance, that nothing really major is stirring the energies for you right now. It all feels pretty business as usual. It has a feeling that business as usual for you entails being really good at what you do. Business as usual is kicking butt and taking names from the feel of it. In that vein, it feels like a very plain-talking, no nonsense kind of reading. It also feels like most of the reading energy is pointing toward work and career thoughts, which would go right along with having a coins card right off the bat like that. The repetitions are asking for attention. You have two swords, which connote action, the element of air, intellect and logic, authority, or your connection with society and culture at large. Knit all of that together and my attention is pulled to using cold, calculating intellect when it comes to work, especially when dealing with the authority structure, or any vying for promotions or power within the structure of the workplace. "Power Play" comes to mind along with an old episode of M\*A\*S\*H where the Colonel accuses someone (Frank? Hotlips? Klinger?) of "going over my head so many times I'm getting athletes scalp" I guess the shorthand for that would be watch out for power playing brown nosers at work. The other repetition is the two kings. Kings connote leadership. It feels like the situation may be asking you for leadership, confidence, self-starting, standing up for yourself....even if you are already good at that, it feels like the skills you have will be put through their paces, and you may even be pushed a tiny bit outside your comfort zone in that respect. I 'hear' (meaning the intuition comes as words instead of feelings or images) to "Hang on and be brave" There was a great meme about spirit guides with a laughing woman on a roller

coaster labeled "my spirit guides" and a screaming boy labeled "me" sitting beside her as they go down a steep hill labeled "life lesson." Your guides feel like they are reminding you they won't lead you anywhere you are not ready to go, but since you are ready...buckle up baby!

### Lessons from the Past King of Coins

This part is the reminder of competence you have, and that you are more than ready to meet leadership challenges at work, or any other part of life, really. The King of Coins as a card connotes wealth and success, so a note of reassurance there again. I hear "build on past skills and successes." I'm not clear whether that means to use the skills and knowledge that you have in hand to fullest advantage, or to build new skills and expand your knowledge and experience...or both. It doesn't feel like a job change as much as an expansion of the current situation.

### Current Situation Three of Swords

Classically, this tends to be a bit darker, more dire card across all of the decks and references that I have. Often it will set me off on maternal lecture mode about being safe, keys out, park under lights, and all that usual lecture....but not so much for you today. This feels more petty than malicious. It isn't the devil or dark side card for good reason. This feels petty, and small, and contained to one aspect of life, like office politics. "Watch out for petty backstabbers" comes to mind. Very office politics, but also heavy on the petty....like an annoying mosquito that can drive you mad if you let it, or just brush it away. The more calm, detached, intellectual and swords / mental-focus the better.

### Moving Forward King of Swords

You know how I read cards...the cards have suit, element, layout position, and general card meaning. But each card, based on all that other stuff, can have a different spin or 'flavor' of message; advice (something to consider doing) caution (something to consider avoiding) or validation (acknowledgement, encouragement, cosmic thank you) There has been a lot of validation energy so far. This has a little more of an advice spin. The card feels less like it pertains to you and more like it represents an ally...someone in the hierarchy at work who you can cultivate a

working relationship with, who can be a mentor of sorts. "Have your back" comes to mind. Like someone who knows your skills, sees your potential. It feels like it might be literally a male figure of some sort. Does any of this ring a bell for you? I'm not sure how else to understand the card, because it has a not-you feel. The card may instead be trying to point you to someone close to you who can help you sort out some of the symbolism given by the card so far. Looking at this card on the Internet to see it from a variety of Tarot decks might give you some ideas about the message that is trying to get through. Beyond that it is dark - meaning no signal, not evil or bad kind of dark. It feels like this card is giving one short message right now: seek out a mentor or ally at work.

Summary

This part is like a psychic "cold reading" where I'll give you any impressions that come to mind. In readings that have a topic or question, this part might connect to the question or the cards....or it might not. In an open reading like this one, it just stays in the open frame of mind.

Often it starts with colors, or crystals or both. In this case I see citrine. It associates with the solar plexus chakra, and therefore confidence. Wear or carry it for confidence at work. It also resonates with the King cards, and the coins suit because the golden color has to do with wealth, career, luck and to some extent leadership. I taste butterscotch, with lemon scent in the background. That might be a continuation of the golden color associations. Butterscotch may symbolize comfort, while lemon in aromatherapy is very cleansing and energizing. Lemon may be important relevant to work, as diffusing some lemon fragrance, lighting a lemon scented candle, or using anything lemon after work might do two things...first it would be a clear transition signal. It could remind you work is done, clear any annoyances or negativity from your day, and let you know to shift into family/home/private life mode. It will also lift your energy...stress or pettiness at work can put an extra drain on your energies. Lemon could help neutralize that and lift your energy after a long day. Don't use citrus oils on your skin if you will be in sunlight within the next 12 hours...it can cause sun sensitivity. Also don't put it on your skin if you have autoimmune diseases as it enhances immunity (a good thing in cold/flu season for most people)

And there the energies step back. I hope this helps! - R.

More Than Meets the Card

There is much more to Tarot than this short introduction. There are reasons why professional readers are, well, professionals. We put time and work into honing our skill just as much as any other professional. Behind this simple card structure lies a mountain of thought, practice, blog writing and Tarot reading experience. Meet Your Reader

I've been reading Tarot and Oracle cards since the early 1990s. At first I read just for myself and a few very close friends. Around 1991 to my great relief and happiness, I finally worked up the courage to leave evangelical Christianity. As I explored a whole new world of spirituality and philosophy, Taoism and Tarot always came naturally. Time and time again, Taoism and Tarot were a source of strength and inspiration, always just what I needed just when I needed it the most.

That, plus I was just too cheap to pay the huge phone rates to talk to those oh-so-popular telephone psychics of the time.

It turns out I had a knack for doing intuitive readings, and my best friend suggested that I try my hand at doing professional readings online. My Ph.D dissertation was on the horizon so I could not argue with the idea of a little extra income. I'll always be grateful to her for that piece of advice. It, no exaggeration, changed my life.

In the early 2000s, I began reading online under the handle "Baihu" on websites like Keen, Advice Trader, and AllExperts. Soon after that, around 2003, came professional readings in the Pittsburgh area including the Modern Oracle Tarot website and the Tarotbytes blog. From 2015 - 2017 I was honored to be a part of David S. Dears podcast, Menage A Tarot. In 2018, I bundled Reiki and Meditation tutorials from my natural health Ph.D work together with my Tarot work and Modern Oracle Tarot became the TaoCraft Tarot that you see today.

Like everyone else in this business, I didn't start out intending to be a professional "psychic" intuitive. I have a Bachelor of Science in Medical Science, which started out with a nice, normal 13 years of clinical experience in psychiatry and cardiology.

Eventually I wanted to move to independent practice, and sought a Ph.D. in Natural Health (CCNH 2011). I've been a Reiki Master-practitioner in the Usui style since 2000 and am a retired Tai Chi instructor. I'm even an online ordained minister with the Universal Life Church and performed a wedding for some friends once.

Along with all of that, I've always had side-passion for writing. Being a writer at heart is why I can type out email distance Tarot as easily as other psychics speak. I've written a nonfiction article about the herbal uses of dandelion for *Point of Light* magazine. I've had articles about Tarot in *Find Your Psychic* online magazine plus poetry published in *Kindred* magazine and in *Quicksilver Moon*, *Nature's Echoes*, and *Beloved Poets of America 1994* (Sparrowgrass Poetry Forum) anthologies. My self-published titles include *PeaceTarot* and *Triquetra: The Dance of Worlds*.
